ENROLLMENT FEE REFUND POLICY

Students are responsible for dropping the classes they no longer wish to attend. To be eligible for a refund of enrollment fees, a dropped class must have been dropped on or prior to the refund deadline for that particular class. The refund deadline for any particular class is calculated at 20% of the class meeting days scheduled between the start and end dates for that particular class. For example, if a class is scheduled to meet twice a week for a total of 30 class meetings, the refund deadline would be the 6th class meeting (20% of the 30 class meeting days). Full-term courses will always have a fixed refund deadline published in the Schedule of Classes each semester. Weekends and legal holidays are excluded from the calculation teaching days.

TEXTBOOK RENTAL FEE REFUNDS

Semester Course	=	Application must be filed in the Bookstore prior to the first meeting of the third week of the course.
Eight Week Course	=	Application must be filed in the Bookstore prior to the first meeting of the second week of the course.
